- Go out as many evenings as possible over the next 2 weeks and observe the moon and its shape.
- Record the date and draw what the moon looked like on that evening. If the weather is overcast just make a note on that date of the weather.
- Label the pictures with the exact phase of the moon. There are many lunar or moon calendars online. Go to www.google.com and enter moon calendar.
- If you do not have internet access, students will have the opportunity to label their journal at school.
- Journals will be due October 16th.
